Senator Tom Brandt Files for Reelection to Represent District 32

(Plymouth, NE) – Today Nebraska State Senator Tom Brandt announced he has filed the appropriate paperwork with the Nebraska Secretary of State’s office to officially run for reelection in 2022.

“Four years ago the voters of District 32 chose me to be their representative in the Legislature and I am asking them to again elect me to serve a second term,” Brandt said. “During the past four years I have been advocating and supporting the issues important to District 32.”

Legislative District 32 includes all of Fillmore, Jefferson, Saline and Jefferson Counties, along with the southwestern portion of Lancaster County.

In 2018, Brandt advanced as the winner of a three-way primary election and went on to win the general election. Since being elected to the Legislature, Brandt has been a staunch advocate for property tax relief, better broadband access, and fairness in school funding.

“I campaigned on the issues of property tax relief, expanded broadband, and addressing the school funding formula to better help the constituents in my district,” Brandt added. “I am running for a second term to continue improving these issues for our district.”

Brandt is a farmer and livestock feeder from Plymouth, NE. Brandt is a graduate of Tri-County High School and earned a degree in Agriculture from the University of Nebraska. He is a past chair and member of the Southeast Nebraska Corn Growers, served nine years on the Board of Directors of the Farmers Cooperative Dorchester, is a past member of the Farm Credit Services of America Advisory Council, past president and active member of the Plymouth Improvement Association, and past president of First Trinity Lutheran Church. Brandt and his wife Sandra have two grown children, Mariah and Evan.

“I will continue standing for the voters of District 32,” Brandt stated. “Since being elected, I have continued to reach out to meet with and listen to the people of LD 32 and will continue doing so if re-elected to continue as your State Senator.”
